## **MINUTES OF MEETING**

At the outset, DGHS welcomed the participants and informed them that the Governing Body of Delhi Arogya Kosh in its meeting held on 15.02.2017 resolved that financial assistance shall be provided to bonafide residents of Delhi, irrespective of their income status and duration of their residency in Delhi, who are undergoing treatment in 30 Hospitals and 23 Polyclinics run by GNCTD, and are advised radiological/ imaging tests (MRI, CT scan, USG, Doppler, Mammography, Echo, TMT, EEG, EMG, PET CT & Radionucleotide scan) by the treating doctors of the hospital/ polyclinic concerned, through Delhi Arogya Kosh.

The participants were further informed that eligible patients (bonafide residents of Delhi) undergoing treatment in the 30 Hospitals run by GNCTD requiring MRI/ CT scan/ USG/ Doppler/ Mammography/ Echo/ TMT/ EEG/ EMG/ PET CT/ Radio-nucleotide scan shall be referred to the Nodal Officer (DAK) of the hospital concerned by the treating doctor through the HOD concerned.

Similarly, eligible patients (bonafide residents of Delhi) undergoing treatment in the 23 polyclinics run by GNCTD requiring USG/ Doppler/ Mammography/ Echo/ TMT/ EEG/ EMG/MRI/ CT scan shall be referred to the Incharge of the Polyclinic concerned by the treating doctor.

The treating doctor shall ensure that his signature and stamp is affixed on the OPD slip. All such OPD slips are to be countersigned by the HOD concerned/ Incharge of Polyclinic concerned and <u>must</u> bear his/her seal.

In case the patient requires contrast enhanced CT scan/PET CT/ Radio-Nucleotide Scan, the treating doctor shall ensure that the latest laboratory report of Urea and Creatinine is attached with the OPD slip.

Nodal Officer, DAK shall maintain all due diligence in verifying either of the following Photo Identity Proof w.r.t. residency in Delhi submitted by the patient:

- 1) Aadhaar Card
- 2) Voter ID
- 3) Driving Licence
- 4) Passport
- 5) Ration card (valid for Head of family)
- 6) Birth Certificate alongwith Photo Identity proof (1 to 5 above) of either of the parent for children below five years of age

After the receipt of all requisite documents, an authorization letter in duplicate is to be issued by the Nodal Officer (DAK)/ Incharge Polyclinic in favour of DAK empanelled radiological/imaging centre. The patient shall be provided authorization letter in original and the list of the approved radiological/imaging centre alongwith the name and mobile

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number of the contact persons for seeking appointment and pre-test advice/instruction, if any. The format of the authorization letter was provided to all the participants.

(Note: The name of the centre must not be mentioned on the authorization letter. The patient is free to go to any of the approved centre as per his /her choice and convenience).

Nodal Officer, Delhi Arogya Kosh shall maintain the following documents for record

- a) Copy of relevant OPD slip mentioning the advice for radiological/ imaging test by the treating doctor bearing his/her signature & seal and counter signed by HOD concerned.
- b) Copy of Photo ID proof
- c) Copy of authorisation letter.

Incharge Polyclinic shall maintain the following documents for record purposes:

- a) Copy of relevant OPD slips mentioning the advice for radiological/ imaging test by the treating doctor bearing his/her signature & seal.
- b) Copy of Photo ID proof
- c) Copy of authorisation letter.

Nodal Officer, Delhi Arogya Kosh/ Incharge, Polyclinic shall submit a statement of cases referred to DGEHS empanelled diagnostic centres to the O/o Delhi Arogya Kosh on a monthly basis latest by the seventh day of subsequent month. This statement shall be duly verified by the Medical Director/ Director/ Coordinating MS/ Medical Superintendent of the hospital or attached polyclinic concerned. The following details are to be mentioned in the statement and the format was provided to all the participants:

- a) Name of the patient
- b) Type of Identity Proof
- c) ID Proof No.
- d) Name of Test
- e) Code No. of the test
- f) Name of treating doctor
- g) Date of referral

Delhi Arogya Kosh has entered into an agreement, for two years, with the 21 (twenty one) radiological/imaging centres empanelled under DGEHS to provide the services at DGEHS

Payment to the centres shall be made by DAK on a monthly basis on the receipt of bills alongwith the original authorization letters submitted by the approved centres, latest by

Member Secretary, DAK & DGHS directed the hospital authorities to designate link Nodal Officers and link Incharge Polyclinics and to send their details to the O/o Delhi Arogya

Chairman, DAK & Hon'ble Minister of Health, GNCTD informed that the hospitals shall continue their existing schemes regarding radiological test for indoor patients, if any and

GIPMER authorities shall proactively work towards procuring their MRI machine. He further informed that this scheme has been conceptualised due to long waiting periods for special diagnostic tests in hospitals (MRI – 2 to 3 years & USG- 3 months) and the scheme shall be reviewed from time to time. Secretary (Health & FW) added that the revised eligibility is for radiological/imaging diagnostic purposes only.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Hon'ble MOH and Secretary (Health).
